said Amherst, Massachusetts, off the northerly side of the right of way leading to Pleasant Street in said Amherst, as shown on a plan entitled: "Plan of Land and Rights of Way in Amherst, Mass. Belonging to Philip L. & Elisabeth D. Gamble and to James R. & Virginia L. Weaver", dated July 21, 1958, prepared by Gordon E. Ainsworth & Associates, recorded in the Hampshire County Registry of Deeds, Plan Book 61, Page 10, and being further bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe set on the northerly side of a twenty foot wide right of way leading to Pleasant Street, being the southwest corner of the tract herein described; thence N. 4° 25' 00" E. one hundred eight and seventy-one hundredths (108.71) feet along land now or formerly of Psi Tau Corp. and also along land now or formerly of Gertrude M. Shampo to an iron pipe; thence N. 4° 36' 10" E. one hundred and thirty hundredths (100.30) feet along said Shampo land to an iron pipe being the northwest corner of the tract herein described; thence S. 82° 23' 00" E. one hundred fifty-seven and forty hundredths (157.40) feet along land now or formerly of George E. Stone to an iron pipe; thence S. 83° 49' 30" E. a distance of seventy-four and sixty-seven hundredths (74.67) feet along said Stone land to an iron pipe being the northeast corner of the land herein described; thence S. 29° 01' 10" W. one hundred fifteen and fifteen hundredths (115.15) feet along land now or formerly of James R. and Virginia L. Weaver to an iron pipe; thence N. 80° 17' 00" W. three and eighty-two hundredths (3.82) feet along land now or formerly of Dale H. and Naomi N. Sieling to an iron pipe; thence S. 10° 33' 10" W. ninety-five and fifty hundredths (95.50) feet along said Sieling land to an iron pipe; thence N. 80° 53' 10" W. forty-four and forty-five hundredths (44.45) feet along said Sieling land to an iron pipe; thence S. 58° 08' 00" W. sixteen and sixty-six hundredths (16.66) feet along said Sieling land to an iron pipe; thence N. 81° 16' 00" W. thirty-four and sixty-six hundredths (34.66) feet along the northerly side of said twenty foot wide right of way leading to Pleasant Street to an iron pipe; thence N. 81° 55' 40" W. seventy-eight and twelve hundredths (78.12) feet along said right of way to the place of beginning; containing 39,696 square feet.

Conveying also those rights of way to North Pleasant Street described in deeds of Duane H. Nash to Fred C. Sears recorded with Hampshire County Registry of Deeds at Book 645, Page 107, dated June 28, 1909, and at Book 666, Page 440, dated April 22, 1911, to which Deeds reference is hereby made for a more particular description and also over the way running along a portion of the northerly boundary of this tract to Butterfield Terrace, which latter way is the same as that described in deed of Mary E. Stone to Fred C. Kenney, dated May 16, 1927, recorded with said Deeds at Book 836, Page 210, to which deed reference is hereby made for a more particular description.

Being the same premises described in deed of John E. Sitter and Deborah Ayer Sitter to grantor herein dated August 15, 1980, and recorded in Hampshire County Registry of Deeds Book 2177, Page 263.
