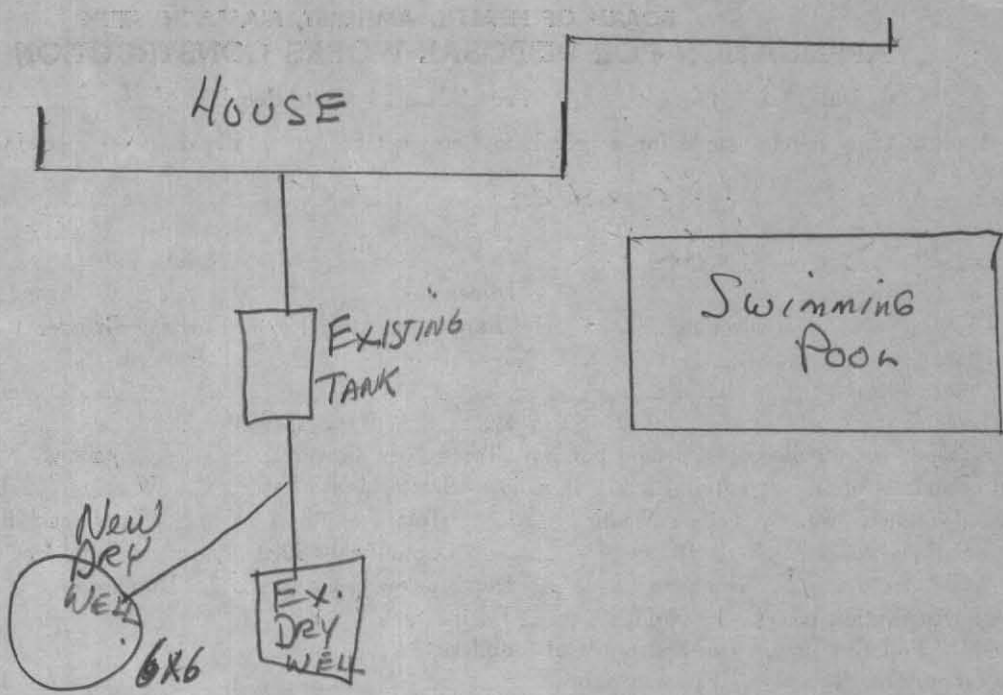

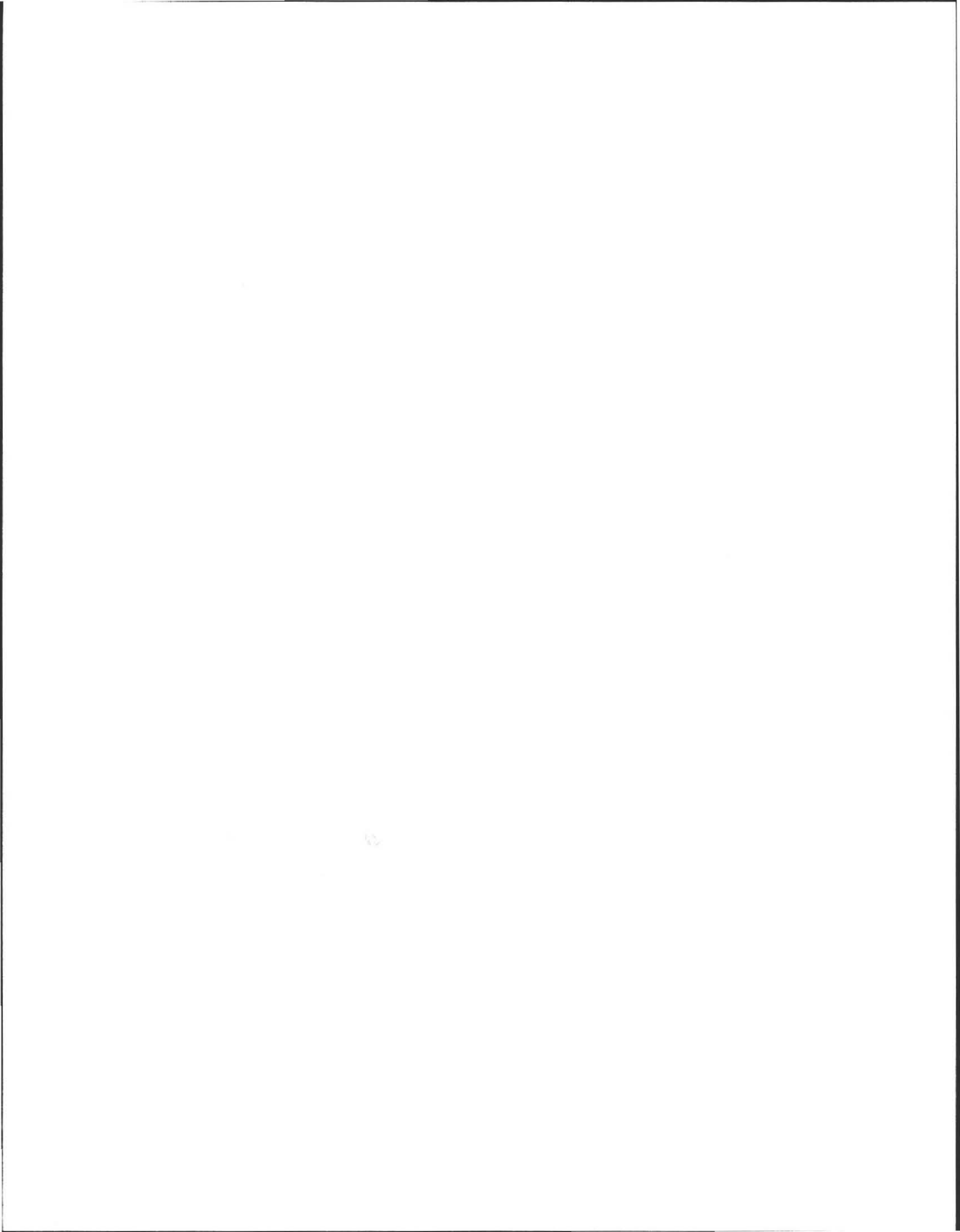

Dr. Thomas Sullivan has applied to me for a permit for a septic tank at 136 Lincoln Ave. The property is now connected to the Town system by a line traversing the property of Mr. William Casey of Sunset Ave.

Dr. Sullivan has in effect by selling this property voided an agreement between he and Mr. Casey on the use of the existing line. This leaves the property without sewerage facilities.

The Town system passing on Amity St. cannot be used to provide Dr. Sullivan with adequate sewerage facilities. Therefore it is the opinion of the Board of Health that the only adequate provision is a septic tank installation.

In reply to your request for a septic tank installation at 136 Lincoln Ave., The Board of Health has agreed to grant you permission for the installation.

After making the required test on the soil, it was determined that a tank of 600 gallons minimum capacity, and a tile field of at least 60 feet will be required for your dwelling.

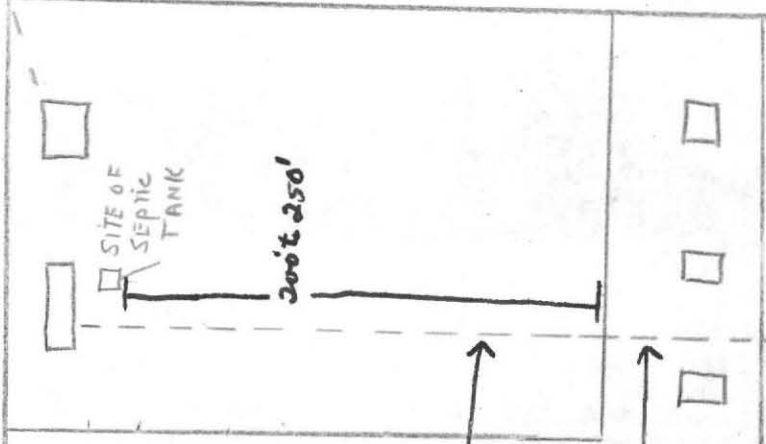
