Leaching System: Trenches of not less than Sq. Ft. bottom area.

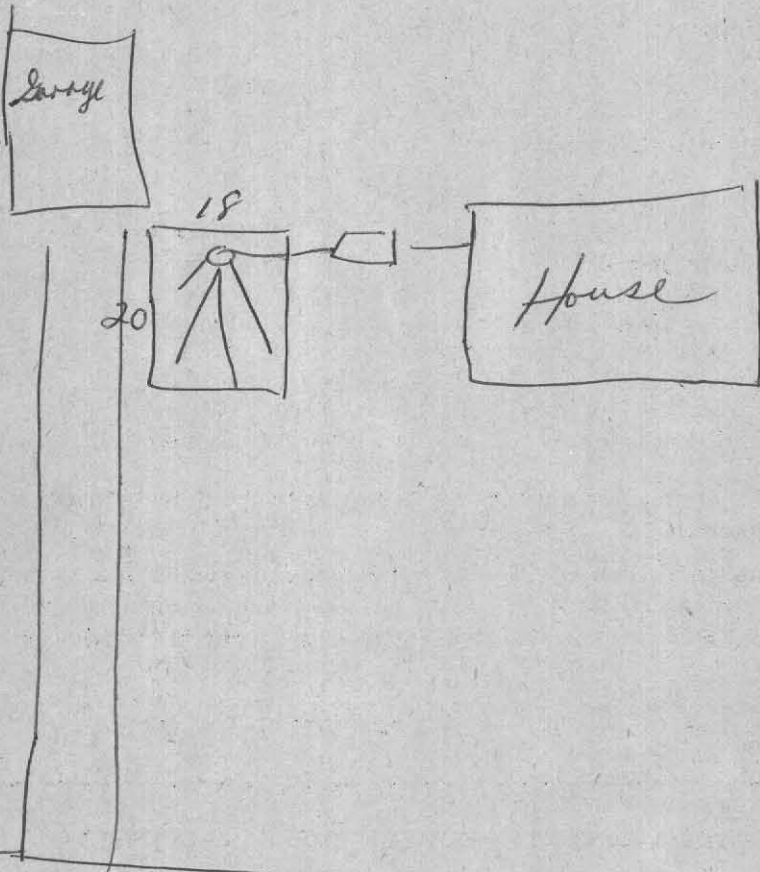
Dry well ft. bottom area and ft. below the inlet.
