PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT OR REPAIR A PRIVATE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM

D.D. Ruxton Co. Inc. is hereby granted permission to proceed with the construction or repair of private sewage disposal system with the following minimum requirements:

Septic Tank: Must be of Cement and of 600 Gals. Liquid Capacity.

Leaching System: Trenches of not less than Sq. Ft. bottom area.

Dry well ft. bottom area and ft. below the inlet.

Other Leach 400 sq ft.

This permit is issued with the understanding that future alterations or additions will be made if necessary. This permit shall not be construed as permission to create or maintain any sewage nuisance and in the issuance of this permit the Board of Health assumes no responsibility for the future operation or maintenance of the system.
