

 - (ii) who does not occupy or intend to occupy the premises as his/her principal residence.





COMMENTS

1. *If the home is owned by a married couple and:*
 - (a) *both occupy or intend to occupy it as their principal residence, then the declaration must be signed by both spouses (unless the non-signing spouse has already signed or contemporaneously signs a declaration under M.G. L. c. 188, § 2).*
 - (b) *only one occupies it or intends to occupy it as his/her principal residence, then the declaration:*
 1. *must be signed by only the resident spouse, and*
 2. *must set forth the name (but not the address) of the declarant's spouse.*
2. *If the home is owned by a married person but not by his/her spouse, then the declaration:*
 - (a) *must set forth the name of the non-titled spouse, and*
 - (b) *must state whether the non-titled spouse also occupies or intends to occupy the premises as his or her principal residence. If the non-titled spouse lives elsewhere, the address of the non-titled spouse does not need to be set forth.*
