A3	Amh Watershed	white pine stand	about 500 ' N of dike at E end of Atkins Res. 5' E of main trail between two diagonally cut stumps 4' high	Continue along trail, joining the main (larger) trail until you come to the last cove on the right. You are on the trail at the west end of the cove. (Amherst Watershed) 700 feet if you walked across the dike to Market Hill Road. Habitat has not changed.	42.4218	-72.4802
A4	Amh Watershed	open grass next to open water w, shrubs E	at center of dike E end of Atkins Res. E side just above dropoff next to mowed strip, at jutting-out point of dike	Continue around the reservoir to the center of the dike, at the point in the dike where it juts away from the water. A5	(in road)	brushy area next to road and pond	on Market Hill Rd between the two ponds S. of Atkins Res across from utility pole #9 at pull-in area S. side of road	Go east on Market Hill Road to between the two ponds.
