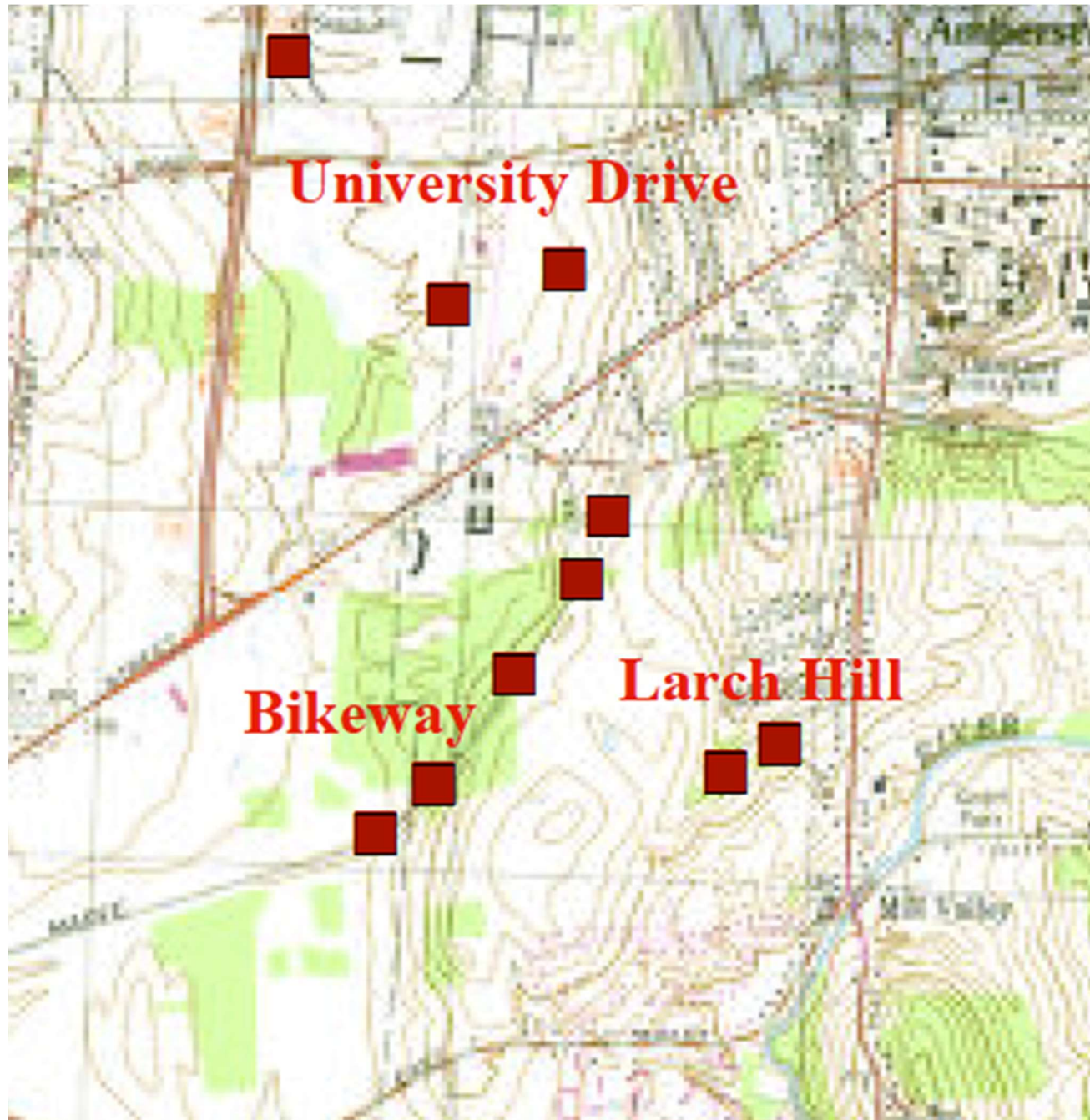

B2	Mass DEM	wet woods	1050' S of Snell Street, E of tracks under 6" red maple SE of ties; off end of golf course	1050' S of Snell Street, (or 546' from B1)	42.3631	-72.5304
B3	Mass DEM	wet woods	at SW corner of golf course and NW corner of farm field, 90' N of culvert; 5' W of ties at 4" elm	Located at southern end of chain link fence which borders east side of bikeway. View of golf course to east. at gate to apartments, new apartments may not have changed species, birding was better to south anyway.	42.3607	-72.5326
B4	Mass DEM	wet woods	S side of R/W under 4" red maple with steep banks each side of R/W; 450' S of culvert at stream	470 L' south, measured from checkpoint 3 (s. end of chain link fence). Steep banks rising u on both sides. Currently coincides with end of new houses (light grey siding) on west side. "at small bridge (for cows going between fields)"	42.3579	-72.5353
B5	Mass DEM	wet woods	at culvert/bridge at Amherst/Hadley town line, W side of R/W under 5" sumac, with view of field to W in Hadley and field to S	located at the 2"x6" (painted brown) section of rail fence which is also the Amherst/Hadley town line. A section of split rail fence will be passed en route. View of farm fields on both sides."now guard rail with trail to cornfield to S (no townline sign)"	42.3567	-72.5372

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
