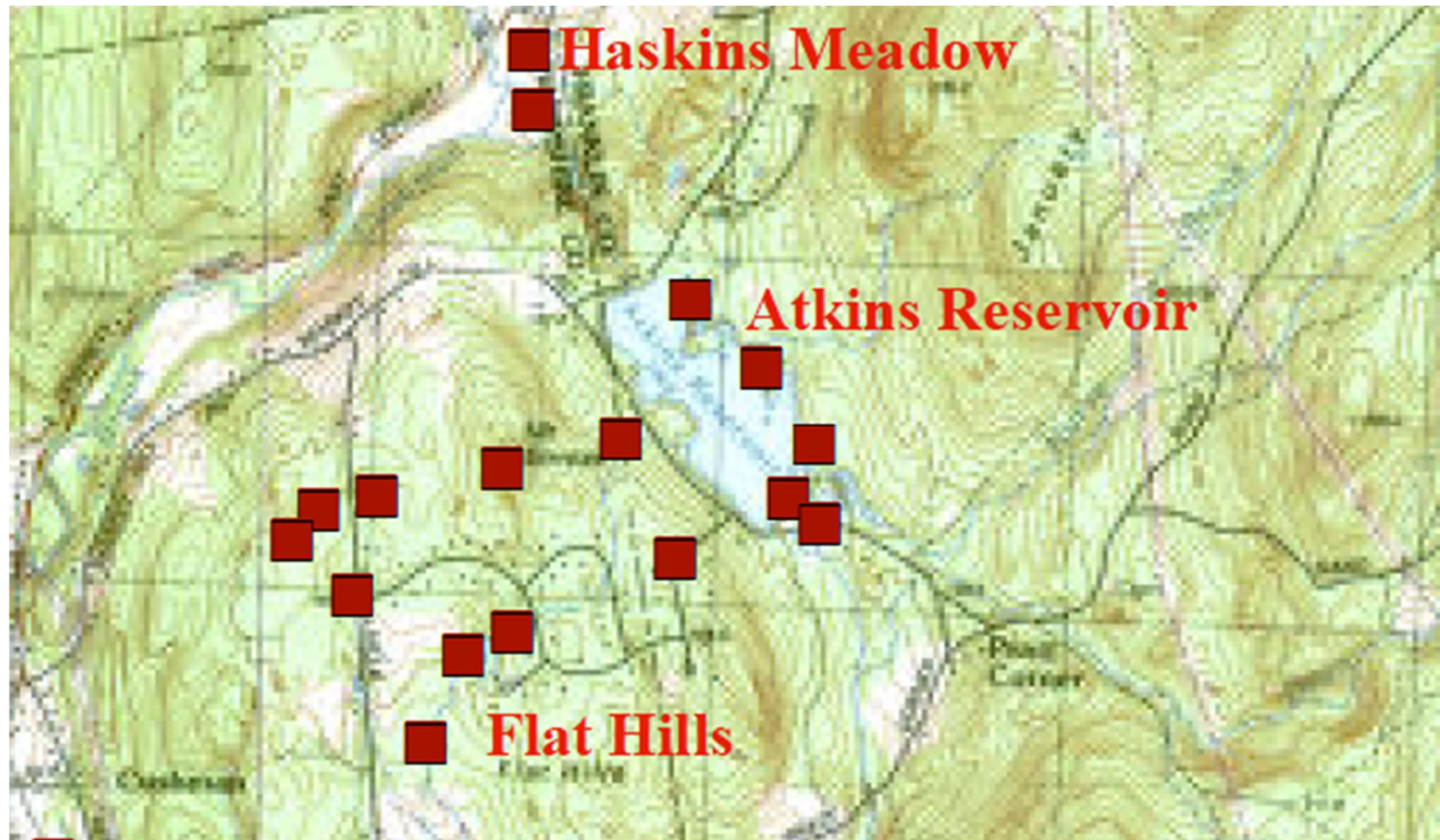

| H1                           | M.Spence   | open field next to small woods, shrub swamp, streams | at 24" old gnarly maple at the end of the woods on your left as you walk in on the grassy farm road across the 1st culvert from the Spence driveway; spike is on S side of tree | Turn at driveway to 597/599 Cushman Rd. Gnarly maple tree is now gnarly stump. Habitat probably same at site, but area between two sites is being changed by beavers (and ConCom beaver-deceivers) | 42.4318 -72.4903   |
| H2                           | AmConLand  | open wet meadow next to shrub swamp & wet woods      | at SE corner of south field (cross 2nd culvert to reach field), 15' SE of mowed edge under double red maple that forks 2.5 feet above the ground; spike is on N side of tree    | Present site is on the path near the corner not under the tree. Probably same mix of habitats over time  | 42.4303 -72.4901   |
